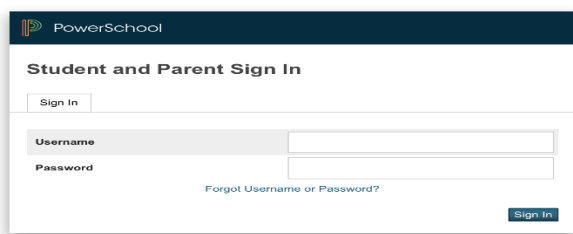

Oct. 30, 2001 is 10302001	June 17, 2001 is 6172001

### UNDERSTANDING COURSE CODES

Course Codes consist of 6 digits. For example: **CGC1DR**  
The first three digits are letters that indicate the course.  
**CGC** = Geography of Canada  
The fourth digit indicates the grade.  
**1** = Grade 9  
The fifth digit indicates the pathway.  
**D** = Academic **P** = Applied **L** = Locally Developed **O** = Open  
The sixth digit is a place holder and is usually an **R**.  
**I** = Immersion **F** = Female **M** = Male **2** = Specialty Course

### PATHWAYS

**Academic Courses (D)** develop students' knowledge and skills through the study of theory and abstract problems. (Pathway to College, Apprenticeship and University)

**Locally Developed (L)** courses develop students' knowledge and skills through practical applications and concrete examples. (Pathway to Workplace and possibly Apprenticeship)

**Applied Courses (P)** develop students' knowledge and skills through practical applications and concrete examples. (Pathway to College, Apprenticeship, Workplace and possibly University)

**Alternate Courses (K)** develop students' life skills and practical academic knowledge. (Pathway to the community)
