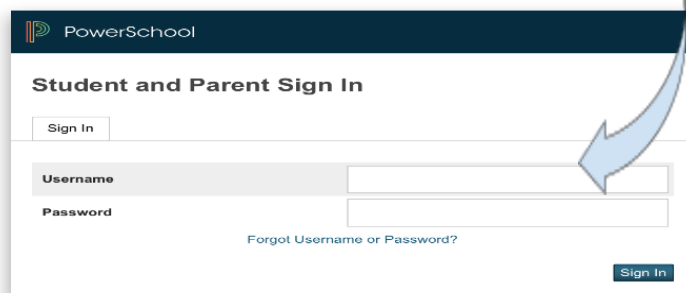

UNDERSTANDING COURSE CODES

Course Codes consist of 6 digits. For example: **CGC1DR**

The first three digits are letters that indicate the course.
CGC = Geography of Canada

The fourth digit indicates the grade.
1 = Grade 9

The fifth digit indicates the pathway.
W = Destreamed **L** = Locally Developed **D** = Academic **O** = Open

The sixth digit is a placeholder and is usually an **R** or **I** = Immersion, **F** = Female, **M** = Male

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WHY DESTREAMING?

The research on streaming is clear: Indigenous, Racialized, Black, low income and special needs students are significantly more likely to be streamed into applied or locally developed classes which leads to poor learning outcomes and fewer postsecondary options than those of their academic peers. Streaming is an inequitable practice for our most vulnerable populations; it is time to make an evidence based, provincial-level change to academic streaming in Ontario.
